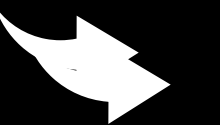

1. Visit <https://www.athernex.tech/> to open the Devfolio dashboard from the Athernex webpage.
2. Find and click the Devfolio registration link.
3. Sign up for a Devfolio account (if you don't have one).
4. Create a team or join an existing team using the team code, and there is NO REGISTRATION FEES.



REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

5. Complete your profile/team details and submit your application for review.
6. The organizers will review your application and notify you of the result.
7. If accepted, you'll receive an email in which further instructions will be given.
8. On the hackathon day, follow the organizer's check-in instructions.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

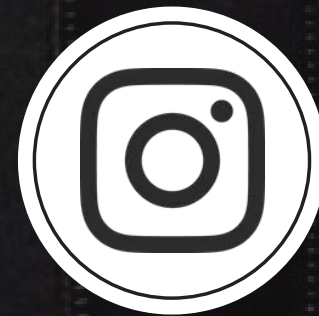
1. Participants must register as a pre-formed team (up to 4 members).
2. Teams must coordinate respectfully; disrespectful team names may lead to disqualification.
3. Joining multiple teams during the hackathon is not allowed.
4. Projects will be evaluated by mentors and judges on innovation, feasibility, impact, and presentation.
5. Attendees must follow all directives from organizers and judges.
6. Projects must align with the chosen tracks; major deviations may result in disqualification from prizes.
7. Professional and respectful behavior is mandatory. Harassment, discrimination, or offensive actions will not be tolerated.
8. Use of external open-source software, libraries, and resources is allowed unless otherwise prohibited.
9. Organizers, judges, or mentors may provide feedback and suggestions to help improve projects.
10. Participants must regularly check emails or other communication channels for updates.
11. By participating, teams grant organizers the right to use their names and project descriptions for promotional purposes.
12. Participants are responsible for their equipment and belongings. Organizers are not liable for any lost items
